South Carolina Quail Project Fall Field Day at Black River Planatation

Black River Plantation is a 1500-acre property in Georgetown County, South Carolina located on the outer banks of the Black River. This is an exquisite property steeped in tradition with a magnificent plantation house listed on the historic National Registry and long-term habitat management goals of restoring native Longleaf Pine ecosystems. Recent land management efforts have focused on the conversion of Loblolly timber stands to native Longleaf and reclaiming forested uplands to quality bobwhite habitat.

Today, Black River is a prime example of how one can overcome challenges often faced outside the traditional quail belt to successfully produce bobwhite habitat. The dedication to bringing back bobwhites on Black River Plantation is obvious and unparalleled. Address: 5119 Choppee Rd., Georgetown, SC 29440. Black River Plantations is approximately 7 miles north of Georgetown.

From Georgetown - take 701-N 7 miles, then turn left on Choppee Rd. Travel 4.1 miles to Dillon Rd. and turn left on Dillon Rd. Go approximately 1 mile to the first stop sign and turn left through gate.

From Hemingway - take Hwy. 261-East to Choppee Rd. for ~10.2 miles to Dillon Road and turn right onto Dillon Rd. Go approximately 1 mile to stop sign then take left through gate.
